The janitorial services will include cleaning the general area main lobby, public restrooms, lobby and hallway areas, and the Department of Development and Auto Title Department pursuant to the attached RFQ/County Performance Standards. The cost shall not exceed \$1,500.00 per month (3% increase after 12 months), which will be paid from Fund 01060. The term of this Contract is September 1, 2023 through September 1, 2025 (2 Years). Multiple quotes were sought: Environment Control, Tipp City, OH - \$1,624.00/Month; Integrity Service Group, West Milton, OH - \$1500/Month; Quinn's Commercial Cleaning Services, Fairborn, OH - \$1800.00/Month (\$180.50/week).
