BY SIGNING BELOW, EACH PARTY WAIVES THE NECESSITY OF THE MAGISTRATE'S DECISION BEING PREPARED AND FILED BY THE MAGISTRATE, SERVICE OF THE SAME, AND FURTHER WAIVES THE TIME PERIOD FOR FILING OBJECTIONS TO SAID DECISION AS PROVIDED BY CIVIL RULES 53 AND CONSENTS TO THE IMMEDIATE FILING OF A JOURNAL ENTRY-DECREE OF DIVORCE/DISSOLUTION OF THE PARTIES IN THIS MATTER.
