



## SANITARY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT

The Miami County Sanitary Engineering Department supplies your water and/or sewer service. Non Metered service customers are charged a Flat Rate. Metered customers are read monthly by remote around the 15<sup>th</sup>. Bills are mailed out the last business day of the month. If you do not receive your bill by the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> please call our office. A 10% penalty will be posted to your account if the payment has not been received by the 15<sup>th</sup> and a Past Due Notice will be mailed. A duplicate copy of any Past Due Notice will be sent to Rental Property Owners. If payment is not in our office by the delinquent due date, a \$35.00 non-payment service charge will be added to your account and the water will be disconnected.

### Payment Options:

- At our office with cash, check, money order, and/or credit/debit card.
- Credit/Debit cards and/or E-Checks can be processed @ [www.miamicountyohio.gov](http://www.miamicountyohio.gov).
- Auto Pay (ACH). Bill is automatically debited from a checking or savings account every month with a completed form that is submitted to the Miami County Sanitary Engineering Office.
- A 24 hour deposit box is located on the east side of the County Safety Building located at 201 W. Main St. Troy, Ohio 45373.
- A deposit box is accessible Monday through Friday 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and on Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the Sanitary Engineering Office.
- The Sanitary Engineering Department is **not** set up to receive electronic payments from your bank. Electronic payments are sent to a Payment Processing Center that physically sends a check. This process can take 10 to 14 days.

The Sanitary Engineering Return Check Policy Fee is \$35.00.

Miami County has a Summer Sewer Credit program beginning in May and ending in October. It is automatically applied to residential customers who qualify.
