You are hereby notified that an Order granting Legal Custody will cause the removal of the child from the legal custody of the parents, guardian or custodian and vest in the person granted Legal Custody of the child the physical care and control of the child, including the right to decide where or with whom the child shall live, and the duty to protect, train, discipline and provide the child with food, shelter, education and medical care subject to any residual rights, privileges and responsibilities of the child's parents.

An order granting Legal Custody is intended to be permanent in nature and may not be modified or terminated unless the Court finds that there is a change in the circumstances of the child or legal custodian and that the modification or termination is in the best interests of the child.
